




#### BREAKDOWN OF POPULATION GROWTH IN PINELLAS COUNTY




# **EMPLOYMENT HEAT MAP**



#### PERCENT INCREASE IN EMPLOYMENT




# **UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (2019-2023)**
























