A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TRANSFER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 FROM THE BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY (0001) TO THE MAYORS OFFICE SCHOOLS GRANTS DIVISION (020-1253); AND APPROVING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000 TO THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA ST. PETERSBURG TO FUND A PILOT ADDRESS **ADVERSE** PROGRAM TO IN SOUTH **EXPERIENCES** CHILDHOOD AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY: PINELLAS MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2018, the City Council Youth and Family Services Committee ("Committee") heard a presentation regarding a pilot program aimed to provide trauma-informed education training for children and their families and to develop resilience practices in light of adverse childhood experiences ("Pilot Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Committee recognizes the challenges faced by youth who are exposed to toxic stress and trauma, and the Committee desires to support the efforts of the University of South Florida St. Petersburg in creating a Pilot Program to gain a better understanding of what kind of program would be most effective in helping this demographic within our community; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$30,000 for the Pilot Program is currently available in the Fiscal Year 2018, Mayor's Office Schools and Grants Division budget; and

WHEREAS, a transfer in the amount of \$5,000 from the balance of the General Fund contingency (0001) to the Mayor's Office Schools and Grants Division (020-1253) is required; and

WHEREAS, after this transfer the balance in the General Fund contingency will be \$575,372.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that there is hereby approved the following transfer from the balance of the General Fund contingency (0001) for Fiscal Year 2018:

General Fund contingency (0001)(\$5,000)Mayor's Office Schools and Grants (020-1253)\$5,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding in the amount of \$35,000 to the University of South Florida St. Petersburg to fund a pilot program to address adverse childhood experiences in South Pinellas County is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
