TO: The Honorable Ed Montanari, Chair, and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: A resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant in the amount of \$101,625 from the U.S. Department of Justice ("DOJ"), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services ("COPS") for a multi-faceted community engagement project. These activities create positive interactions between youth, the overall community and the police department, including expansion of "Not My Son" a community-based violence intervention & youth engagement program; and to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$101,625 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these grant revenues to the Police Department, Fiscal Support Division (140-1389), Community Engagement Project FY22 (18819); and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION: The COPS Microgrant ("Grant") has been awarded by DOJ to The City of St. Petersburg ("CITY") in the amount of \$101,625 for this project. The Grant requires no matching funds. The CITY will serve as the representative to this grant and will be responsible for the grant over the year term. The CITY will submit expenditure reports to DOJ for reimbursement of all eligible costs. and the police department.

RECOMMENDATION: The Administration recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept the grant award of \$101,625 from the DOJ COPS program; and to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$101,625 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from these grant revenues resulting, to the Police Department, Fiscal Support Division (140-1389), Community Engagement Project FY22 (18819); and providing an effective date.

COST/FUNDING INFORMATION: Revenues of up to \$101,625 are to be received from the DOJ COPS and deposited into the General Fund (0001). Funds will be available after the approval of a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$101,625 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these grant revenues, to the Police Department, Fiscal Support Division (140-1389), Community Engagement Project FY22 (18819).

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE ("DOJ"), OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING ("COPS") GRANT IN THE MAXIMUM REIMBURSEMENT AMOUNT OF \$101,625 TO FUND A MULTI-FACETED COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE TRANSACTION: APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL Α APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$101,625 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND (0001), RESULTING FROM THESE GRANT REVENUES, TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FISCAL SUPPORT DIVISION (140-1389),COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PROJECT FY22 (18819); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg ("City") applied for and has been awarded a DOJ COPS grant ("Grant") for the period of September 1, 2021 through August 30, 2022, in the maximum reimbursement amount of \$101,625 to fund a multi-faceted community engagement project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project activities are intended to create positive interactions between youth, the overall community, and the police department, including the expansion of "Not My Son", a community-based violence intervention & youth engagement program; and

WHEREAS, the City will submit expenditure documentation to the DOJ for reimbursement of eligible costs; and

WHEREAS, the Grant requires no local matching funds; and

WHEREAS, a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$101,625 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from the Grant funds is required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept a U.S. Department of Justice ("DOJ"), Office of Community Oriented Policing ("COPS") grant in the maximum reimbursement amount of \$101,625 to fund a multi-faceted community engagement project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of his designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these grant revenues, the following supplemental appropriation for FY22:
