Subject: Approving the purchase of one rear loader truck from Container Systems & Equipment Co., Inc. for the Sanitation Department, at a total cost of \$286,311; approving a transfer in the amount of \$286,311 from the unappropriated balance of the Sanitation Operating Fund (4021) to the Sanitation Equipment Replacement Fund (4027); approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$286,311 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Sanitation Equipment Replacement Fund (4027), resulting from the above transfer, to the Sanitation Department, Administration Division (450-2237).

Explanation: This purchase is being made from Florida Sheriffs Association Contract No. FSA20-VEH18.0.

The vendor will furnish and deliver one rear end loader truck. The rear end loader truck will be powered by a Cummins L9N 320 HP compressed natural gas (CNG) engine. This new vehicle is a replacement and will be used for the Residential Division as manual route. The new rear loader has a life expectancy of eight to 10 years. This will bring Sanitation's CNG fleet to 87 vehicles.

The Procurement and Supply Management Department, in cooperation with the Sanitation Department, recommends award using Florida Sheriffs Association Contract No. FSA20-VEH18.0.

FOR THE **SANITATION** DEPARTMENT AT A TOTAL COST OF \$286,311 UTILIZING THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION CONTRACT NO. FSA20-VEH18.0; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; APPROVING A TRANSFER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$286,311 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE SANITATION OPERATING FUND (4021) TO THE SANITATION EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND (4027); APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$286,311 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE **SANITATION** EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND (4027), RESULTING FROM THE ABOVE TRANSFER, TO THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT, ADMINISTRATION DIVISION (450-2237); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase one rear loader truck from Container Systems & Equipment Co., Inc. to replace a vehicle that has reached the end of its economic service life for the Sanitation Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-219(c) of the St. Petersburg City Code allows the City to purchase vehicles from the Florida Sheriffs Association negotiated purchase program; and

WHEREAS, Container Systems & Equipment Co., Inc. has met the specifications, terms and conditions of the Florida Sheriffs Association Contract No. FSA20-VEH18.0; and

WHEREAS, funding for this purchase will be available after (i) a transfer in the amount of \$286,311 from the unappropriated balance of the Sanitation Operating Fund (4021) to the Sanitation Equipment Replacement Fund (4027) and (ii) a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$286,311 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Sanitation Equipment Replacement Fund (4027), resulting from the above transfer, to the Sanitation Department, Administration Division (450-2237); and

WHEREAS, the Procurement & Supply Management Department, in cooperation with the Sanitation Department, recommends approval of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the purchase of one rear loader truck from Container Systems & Equipment Co., Inc. for the Sanitation Department at a total cost of \$286,311 utilizing the Florida Sheriffs Association Contract No. FSA20-VEH18.0 is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby approved from the unappropriated balance of the Sanitation Operating Fund (4021), the following transfer for FY22:
