**To: The Honorable James Bennett, Chair and Members of City Council**

**Subject:** Approving the purchase of a replacement fire apparatus for the Fire Department from Hall-Mark Fire Apparatus, Inc. at a total cost of \$814,983.

**Explanation:** This purchase is being made from Florida Sheriff's Association Bid No. 07-07-0828.

The vendor will furnish and deliver one aerial platform unit with 100' and 91.5' vertical and horizontal reach respectively, heavy-duty chassis, 500 hp diesel engine and 65-gallon fuel tank. The additional equipment package includes electronic stability control system; intercom system with radio interface; and a 230 volt hydraulic rescue tool power unit. The package also includes a 54,000-lb load capacity rear axle; 28" front bumper extension; 17" disc brakes and upgrades to aerial ladder brackets, lighting and tires.

The new unit has a life expectancy of 15 years and will be stationed at the Pasadena fire station. It will replace a 12 year-old unit that will be used as a reserve unit. The new vehicle meets 2007 U.S. EPA emission standards for heavy-duty vehicles by producing 90% less nitrogen oxide and 72% less non-methane hydrocarbon exhaust emissions.

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fire Department, recommends for award utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Bid 07-07-0828:





A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT FIRE APPARATUS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM HALL-MARK FIRE APPARATUS, INC. AT A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$814,983 UTILIZING FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION BID NO. 07-07-0828; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City desires to replace a 12-year-old fire apparatus unit; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-234(e) of the City Code permits the City to utilize competitively bid contracts of other governmental entities when it is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Hall-Mark Fire Apparatus, Inc. has met the specifications, terms and conditions of Florida Sheriff's Association Bid No. 07-07-0828; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fire Department, recommends this purchase utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Bid No. 07-07-0828.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the purchase of a replacement fire apparatus for the Fire Department from Hall-Mark Fire Apparatus, Inc. at a total cost not to exceed \$814,983 utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Bid No. 07-07-0828 is approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
