TO: City Council Chair & Members of City Council

SUBJECT:

Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the State of Florida Department of Education ("Department") in an amount up to \$540,195 for the City's summer food program and to execute a grant agreement and all other necessary documents with the Department; approving a supplemental appropriation of \$540,195 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION:

The Florida Department of Education - Food and Nutrition Management will award the City of St. Petersburg funding to provide breakfast and lunch for any child under the age of 18 at 15 recreation centers during the summer - five days a week from June 9 until August 15. This program is funded by the US Department of Agriculture through the state and is accessible by anyone under 18 years of age. A child need not be registered in a City program. The times that the meals are available are posted at each site and any child can receive breakfast and/or lunch. The grant pays for the meals and provides for an administrative cost to run the program. The reimbursement is based on how many meals are provided.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Administration recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the State of Florida Department of Education ("Department") in an amount up to \$540,195 for the City's summer food program and to execute a grant agreement and all other necessary documents with the Department; approving a supplemental appropriation of \$540,195 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date

COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION:

Revenues of approximately \$540,195 will be received from the Florida Department of Education. A supplemental appropriation in City Services Administration-Recreation of \$540,195 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues will be required.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ("DEPARTMENT") IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$540,195 FOR THE CITY'S SUMMER FOOD PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL OTHER NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH THE DEPARTMENT; APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$540,195 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL REVENUES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg's youth are an important and valuable resource; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg Recreation Department applied for and will receive a grant from the State of Florida Department of Education in the amount of \$540,195 to provide funding for the City's Summer Food Program providing breakfast and lunch for any child under the age of 18.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept a grant from the State of Florida Department of Education in an amount up to \$540,195 for the City's Summer Food Program; and to execute a grant agreement and all other necessary documents with the Department; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues, the following supplemental appropriation for fiscal year 2008:




