**TO:** The Honorable James Bennett, Chair, and Members of City Council

**SUBJECT:** Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Task Order No. 06-11-SCI/T to the agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Sprinkle Consulting, Inc. in the amount of \$444,652 for Pinellas Trail / 34<sup>th</sup> Street Pedestrian Bridge. (Engineering Project No. 06103-912; Oracle No. 10622)

**EXPLANATION:** On May 18, 2006, City Council Approved a Master Agreement with the professional consulting engineering firm of Sprinkle Consulting, Inc. for Architect/Engineering services related to Traffic Calming, Bicycle and Pedestrian Projects.

On February 21, 2008, City Council approved entering into an interlocal agreement with Pinellas County providing \$3,500,000 in reimbursement for construction of a Pinellas Trail Pedestrian Bridge over 34<sup>th</sup> Street (US 19). The Pinellas Trail Extension project is scheduled for completion in early June 2008, with a temporary at-grade signal to be provided for trail users to cross 34<sup>th</sup> Street South, near 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue South.

Task Order No. 06-11-SCI/T provides for design services necessary to accommodate three operational phases of the trail crossing. Phase One is an at-grade crossing with temporary span-wire traffic signals; Phase Two is the operation of the at-grade crossing during construction of the trail overpass structure; Phase Three is the permanent overpass structure, trail approach ramps, and 34<sup>th</sup> Street sidewalk access. The scope of work includes geotechnical, structural, and traffic control design services; project coordination and permitting by SWFWMD, FDOT and Pinellas County; and preparing bid documents for the Pinellas Trail Pedestrian Bridge crossing over 34<sup>th</sup> Street South.

Administration recommends authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Task Order No. 06-11-SCI/T with Sprinkle Consulting, Inc. in the amount of \$444,652.




