To: The Honorable James Bennett, Chair and Members of City Council

Subject: Renewing a blanket purchase agreement with P & L Electric, Inc. for city street lighting installation and maintenance for the Internal Services Administration at an estimated annual cost of \$686,750.

Explanation: On March 1, 2007 City Council approved a two year blanket purchase agreement with changes in the estimated annual amount of \$700,800. Under the renewal of contract clause, the City reserves the right to extend the contract for a period of one year if mutually agreeable. This is the first of two one-year renewal options.

The vendor provides all labor, materials, and equipment necessary for installation, and maintenance of street lights and poles. New installations will be performed according to project schedules developed by the Public Response Division of the Internal Services Administration and Neighborhood Partnership in support of the Mayor's street and pedestrian lighting initiatives and other neighborhood and downtown street lighting initiatives. The vendor will also provide installation of new or retrofitting of existing lighting with inductive lighting which provides 50% energy savings and lasts four times as long as the current lighting. New inductive and/or LED lighting projects include Walter Fuller Park, Plaza Parkway, 49th St. Corridor and Feather Sound Executive Drive. Approximately 1,600 city owned pedestrian and roadway street lights will be retrofitted with inductive lighting. Repairs and maintenance will be performed on an as-needed basis.

The Purchasing Department in cooperation with the Internal Services Administration recommends for renewal:


P&L Electric, Inc. (SBE)\$686,750

The vendor has agreed to hold prices firm under the terms and conditions of Bid No.6584 dated January 17, 2007. The renewal will be effective through March 31, 2010.

Cost/Funding/Assessment Information: Funds have been appropriated in the Recreation and Culture Capital Improvements Fund (3029), Walter Fuller Park Improvements FY08 Project (11171) {\$144,000}, Plaza Parkway FY09 Project (12095) [\$60,000], and 49th Street Improvements Project (12062) [\$46,400]; General Capital Improvements Fund (3001) and Neighborhood and Citywide Infrastructure Capital Improvements Fund (3027), Energy Enhancements FY08 Project (11616) [\$167,350] and Executive Drive Project (11674) [\$50,000], and various Neighborhood Partnership grants relating to street lighting [\$89,000]. The maintenance cost will come from the General Fund (0001), Internal Services Administration, Street Lighting & Support (0401027) [\$130,000].

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF AN AGREEMENT (BLANKET AGREEMENT) WITH P & L ELECTRIC, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$686,750 FOR STREET LIGHTING INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE FOR THE INTERNAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2007, City Council approved a two-year agreement (Blanket Agreement) with two one-year renewal options at an annual cost not to exceed \$300,000 with P & L Electric, Inc. for installation and maintenance of street lighting pursuant to Bid No. 6584 dated January 17, 2007; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2008 City Council approved a Change Order to the Agreement due to the addition of other projects resulting in a revised estimated annual cost not to exceed \$700,800; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the first one-year renewal option; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Internal Services Administration, recommends renewal of this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the renewal of the Agreement (Blanket Agreement) with P & L Electric, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$686,750 for street lighting installation and maintenance for the Internal Services Administration is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this renewal will be effective through March 31, 2010.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
