**TO:** The Honorable James Bennett, Chair, and Members of City Council

**SUBJECT:** Awarding a contract to Marine Contracting Group, Inc. in the amount of \$546,019.50 for the construction of City Port Structural Rehabilitation – Phase 2. (Engineering Project No. 01072-217; Oracle No. 11665)

**EXPLANATION:** The work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, services, and equipment necessary to perform structural rehabilitation and repairs to the existing Port Wharf consisting of concrete deck, pile, pile cap, bulkhead cap and longitudinal beam spall/crack repairs; pile cap encasements; and transverse beam replacements at Wharf Units 7 and 8 (Base Bid) and Wharf Unit 6 (Add-Alternate).

The wharf is approximately 1,270 linear feet (LF) long, and is comprised of 13 unit sections, approximately 100 feet long each. These wharf units were originally constructed in the 1940s and have subsequently received concrete structural rehabilitation at various times. Phase I of this project was recently completed including rehabilitation of wharf Units 8 (partial) and wharf Units 9 through 13, located on the east 450 feet of the wharf, abutting the SRI International Facility.

The contractor will begin work approximately ten (10) consecutive calendar days from written Notice to Proceed and is scheduled to complete the work within one hundred eighty (180) consecutive calendar days thereafter. Bids were opened on November 6, 2008 and are tabulated as follows:

Administration recommends awarding this contract to Marine Contracting Group, Inc. in the amount of \$546,019.50.


**COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION:** Under a State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Public Transportation – Joint Participation Agreement with the City, the FDOT will provide funding for seaport terminal improvements (FSTED) matching 50% of the total construction cost for constructing the work. Funds are available in the Port Capital Improvement Fund (4093) and the City Facilities Capital Improvement Fund (3031) Port Wharf Renovations and Improvement Project (11665).




