**TO:** The Honorable James Bennett, Chair, and Members of City Council

**SUBJECT:** Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Amendment 1 to Task Order No. 02-3-PWI/GC to the Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Parsons Water & Infrastructure, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$73,522.00 for services during construction of the Lake Coronado and Vicinity Storm Drainage Improvements. (Engineering Project No. 06043-110, Oracle No. 10684)

**EXPLANATION:** On September 5, 2002, the City Council approved a Master Agreement with the professional consulting engineering firm of Parsons Water & Infrastructure, Inc., formerly known as Parsons Engineering Science, Inc. for engineering services related to the design and construction of Stormwater Management, Roadway and Bridge Improvements (General Civil) Projects.

On February 2, 2006, Task Order No. 02-3-PWI/GC was approved by City Council in an amount not to exceed \$333,379 and provided for the technical and engineering services related to the design of drainage improvements for Lake Coronado and vicinity (7<sup>th</sup> Street to 11<sup>th</sup> Street South, 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue South to 60<sup>th</sup> Avenue South) including surveying, geotechnical testing, subsurface utility location, preparation of the permit applications and the development of construction plans and technical specifications.

Amendment 1 to Task Order No. 02-3-PWI/GC pertains to specific technical and engineering services related to the construction phase of drainage improvements for Lake Coronado and Vicinity.


Parsons Water & Infrastructure Inc.'s scope of services for the construction phase of the project will include attending the pre-construction conference, shop drawing review for the box culvert and endwall related facilities, on call field visits, responses to contractor requests for additional information, and attendance at the final inspection. The sum of the previous design phase services and the pending construction phase services will bring the total of the agreement amounts with Parsons Water & Infrastructure to \$406,901.

Administration recommends approval of Amendment 1 to Task Order No. 02-3-PWI/GC with Parsons Water & Infrastructure, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$73,522.00.


