TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a Local Agency Program Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida ("City") and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for participation by FDOT in the design activities of the City of St. Petersburg - Pinellas Trail Traffic Control Project ("Project") in an amount not to exceed \$30,577; authorizing a supplemental appropriation of \$30,577 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Improvements Fund (3004) resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date (FDOT Financial Project No. 424532-3-38-01)

EXPLANATION: The purpose of this project is to provide preliminary engineering design services for the City of St. Petersburg – Pinellas Trail Traffic Control Project.

This project will be developed under FDOT's Local Agency Program. The City received LAP certification in August 2000 to provide design, bid/award, and construction oversight services for federally funded projects within City limits. As indicated in the LAP Agreement, the estimated total cost is \$30,577. Project costs for design and City staff will be borne initially by the City, and the City will recoup all related project costs from FDOT.

The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, design, permitting and administration of pedestrian traffic safety improvements, including flashing beacons at the following intersections of the Pinellas Trail;

- Pinellas Trail and 49th Street S.
- Pinellas Trail and 58th Street S.

Upon completion of the design phase, a LAP Supplemental Agreement will be provided by FDOT to furnish the construction phase of this Project.

This project will be performed in accordance with all applicable FDOT procedures, guidelines, manuals, standards, and directives as described in the FDOT LAP Manual.

RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends that City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a Local Agency Program Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida ("City") and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for participation by FDOT in the design activities of the City of St. Petersburg - Pinellas Trail Traffic Control Project ("Project") in an amount not to exceed \$30,577; authorizing a supplemental appropriation of \$30,577

from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Improvements Fund (3004) resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date (FDOT Financial Project No. 424532-3-38-01)

COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION: Funds will be available in the Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Improvements Fund (3004) with a supplemental appropriation of \$30,577 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Improvements Fund (3004) resulting from these additional revenues.



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA ("CITY") AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") FOR PARTICIPATION BY FDOT IN THE DESIGN ACTIVITIES OF THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG - PINELLAS TRAIL TRAFFIC CONTROL PROJECT ("PROJECT") IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,577; AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$30,577 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FUND (3004) RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL REVENUES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (FDOT FINANCIAL PROJECT NO. 424532-3-38-01)

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") has agreed to participate in the design activities of the City of St. Petersburg – Pinellas Trail Traffic Control Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, as a requirement for FDOT's participation in the Project, the City of St. Petersburg, Florida ("City") must enter into a Local Agency Program Agreement ("Agreement") setting forth the obligations of FDOT and the City.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute a Local Agency Program Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida ("City") and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for participation by FDOT in the design activities of the City of St. Petersburg - Pinellas Trail Traffic Control Project ("Project") in an amount not to exceed \$30,577.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements Fund resulting from these additional revenues, the following supplemental appropriation:

FDOT – LAP – Pinellas Trail Traffic Control Project	\$30,577




