SUBJECT: A resolution approving a supplemental appropriation of \$32,800 from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023) for FY09 for the purchase of software to enhance administrative processing efficiencies; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION:

The Administration requests an appropriation of \$32,800 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to the Police Department for the purchase of the IAPRO software for the Internal Affairs Unit from C I Technologies, Inc. This software application is the leading Internal Affairs/Professional Standards software used by law enforcement agencies across the USA, Canada and Australia. It will enable the Police Department's Internal Affairs Division to identify potential problems early on, so that proactive action can be taken. It will also ensure the most efficient handling of citizen complaints, administrative investigations, use-of-force reporting, and other types of incidents.

IAPRO's early intervention/early warning features have been reviewed by CLEA accreditation assessment teams during site visits to our customers' sites, and have been found to fully support CLEA requirements in this regard. The total cost of this application is \$32,800 and should be appropriated from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023), Police Department, Federal Justice Forfeiture (140-2858).


RECOMMENDATION:



WHEREAS, the City of St Petersburg, Florida ("City") solicited proposals for internal affairs software for the Police Department pursuant to Request for Proposals 920-04 ("RFP"); and

WHEREAS, C I Technologies, Inc., has met the terms and conditions of the RFP; and

WHEREAS, purchase of the software in the amount of \$32,800 will require a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for FY09.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that there is hereby approved the following supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the FY09:

Police Department (140-2858)




