

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21-86(2) OF THE CITY CODE TO INSERT PINELLAS POINT PARK; ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION 21-87(8); PROVIDING FOR THE RENAMING OF A PORTION OF PINELLAS POINT PARK TO KATHERINE B. TIPPETTS PARK; ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION 21-87(9); PROVIDING FOR CODIFYING THE RENAMING OF A PORTION OF NORTSHORE PARK AS ELVA ROUSE PARK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has received a recommendation from the Policy & Planning Committee to rename a portion of Pinellas Point Park to Katherine B. Tippetts Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the factors set forth in City Code Section 21-88.

THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. The property described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, which was a part of Pinellas Point Park, is hereby renamed to be Katherine B. Tippetts Park.

Section 2. The St. Petersburg City Code is hereby amended by adding a new Section 21-87(8) to read as follows:

(8) Katherine B. Tippetts Park.

a. That portion of the property designated as Pinellas Point Park, No. 68 on the Park and Waterfront Property Map, which is located between 14th Street South and the west side of Serene Way South, extended, is hereby renamed to be the Katherine B. Tippetts Park.

b. The Katherine B. Tippetts Park shall be considered to be a passive park property area as that term is defined within this article

Section 3. The St. Petersburg City Code is hereby amended by adding a new section, 21-86(2)68, to read as follows:

68. Pinellas Point Park (see Ordinance No. __ for a description of that portion of this Park now known as Katherine B. Tippetts Park).

Section 4. The St. Petersburg City Code is hereby amended by adding a new Section 21-87(9) to read as follows:

(9) Elva Rouse Park.

a. That portion of the property designated as North Shore Park, No. 25 on the Park and Waterfront Property Map, which is located between Flora Wylie Park and the north side of 10th Avenue North, extended, is hereby renamed to be the Elva Rouse Park, as was previously provided in Resolution No. 92-897. Elva Rouse Park shall include the Gizella Kopsick Palm Arboretum.

b. The Elva Rouse Park shall be considered to be an active park property as that term is defined within this Article.

Section 5. Section 21-86(1)25 of the St. Petersburg City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

25. North Shore Park (see Section 21-87(9) ~~Resolution No. 82-87~~ for a description of that portion of this Park now known as Elva Rouse Park)

Section 6. Words in underlined type are additions to, and words that are ~~struck thru~~ are deletions from, the existing St. Petersburg City Code.

Section 7. In the event this Ordinance is not vetoed by the Mayor in accordance with the City Charter, it shall become effective upon the expiration of the fifth business day after adoption unless the Mayor notifies the City Council through written notice filed with the City Clerk that the Mayor will not veto the Ordinance, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon filing such written notice with the City Clerk. In the event this Ordinance is vetoed by the Mayor in accordance with the City Charter, it shall not become effective unless and until the City Council overrides the veto in accordance with the City Charter, in which case it shall become effective immediately upon a successful vote to override the veto.
