**To: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council**

**Subject:** Approving the purchase of a replacement fire rescue vehicle from Wheeled Coach Industries, Inc. for the Fire Department at a total cost of \$139,104.

**Explanation:** This purchase is being made from Florida Sheriffs Association Bid No. 08-08-0909. The vendor will furnish and deliver one Type 1 Ambulance “patient transport capable” medical module mounted on a 20,500 lbs GVWR chassis with 6.7L 240hp Cummins engine, Allison 2200 5-speed transmission. The equipment includes reinforced cab console for mobile data terminal, custom interior cabinet layout and exterior compartments with additional shelving, additional LED lights and an external condenser and second compressor.

The ambulance will be used to respond to emergency medical calls. The new vehicle has a life expectancy of seven years. This unit is replacing a seven year-old unit that was purchased by Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services and transferred to the City. It will be used as a reserve unit.



A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT FIRE RESCUE VEHICLE FROM WHEELED COACH INDUSTRIES, INC. AT A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$139,106 FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; UTILIZING FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION BID NO. 08-08-0909; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City desires to replace a seven-year old fire rescue vehicle that was purchased by Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services and transferred to the City; and

WHEREAS, the unit that was transferred to the City will be used as a reserve unit; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-234(e) of the City Code permits the City to utilize competitively bid contracts of other governmental entities when it is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Wheeled Coach Industries, Inc. has met the specifications, terms and conditions of Florida Sheriffs Association Bid; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fire Department, recommends this award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the purchase of a replacement fire rescue vehicle from Wheeled Coach Industries, Inc. at a total cost not to exceed \$139,104 for the Fire Department utilizing Florida Sheriff's Association Bid No. 08-08-0909 is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
