TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Supplement No. 2 to the Local Agency Program Agreement ("Agreement") between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") in an amount not to exceed \$275,000, for a total project cost not to exceed \$2,130,155, for additional funding of the construction activities of the US 92 (4th Street) Sidewalk Project ("Project"); authorizing a supplemental appropriation of \$275,000 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Capital Improvement Fund (3001) resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date. (FPN 406315-1-38/58-01) (Engineering Project No. 05107-110, Oracle No. 10967)

EXPLANATION: On March 2, 2006, City Council approved a Local Agency Program ("LAP") Agreement ("Agreement") with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for construction activities of the US 92 (4th Street) Sidewalk Project ("Project"). On March 7, 2006, the City entered into a Local Agency Program ("LAP") which outlines terms and conditions incumbent upon both parties. Under the LAP program, the City is administering the design and construction of the project and will recoup from FDOT project costs included in the Agreement scope of work and any FDOT-approved supplemental services. Under the original Agreement, the cost of \$1,340,155 provided for design and construction activities for this project.

Supplement No. 1 was approved by City Council on November 1, 2007, provided for additional funds in the amount of \$515,000 for the construction phase of this Project, reimbursable to the City, bringing the total estimated reimbursement cost to \$1,855,155. This additional funding provided for the increased construction costs due to right of way acquisitions, material costs and estimated contractor costs for the construction activities for sidewalk, curb, drainage and signalization improvements on US 92 (4th Street) from 5th Avenue North to 30th Avenue North.

This Supplement No. 2 provides for additional funds in the amount of \$275,000, reimbursable to the City, bringing the total estimated project cost to \$2,130,155, for the increased costs for construction associated with the US 92 (4th Street) Sidewalk Project. These additional funds have been made available for this project as a result of the Department's periodic construction estimate updating process. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the installation of mast arm assemblies, new traffic controllers and signalization equipment, resetting of granite curb and hexblock sidewalks and installation of new concrete sidewalks and ramps on US 92 (4th Street) from 5th Avenue North to 30th Avenue North.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENT NO. 2 TO THE LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$275,000, FOR A TOTAL PROJECT COST NOT TO EXCEED \$2,130,155, FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING OF THE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES OF THE US 92 (4TH STREET) SIDEWALK PROJECT ("PROJECT"); AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$275,000 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (3001) RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL REVENUES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE (FDOT FINANCIAL PROJECT NO. 406315-1-38/58-01) (ENGINEERING PROJECT NO. 05107-110, ORACLE NO.10967)

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg, Florida ("City") and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") entered into a Local Agency Program Agreement ("Agreement") on March 28, 2006, for FDOT's participation in the design and construction activity of the US 92 (4th Street) Sidewalk Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, City Council approved Supplement No. 1 on November 1, 2007, to provide additional funding for the construction activities of the Project in an amount not to exceed \$515,000 for a total Project cost not to exceed \$1,855,155; and

WHEREAS, the City and FDOT wish to further supplement the Agreement to provide more funding for the construction activities of the Project in an amount not to exceed \$275,000 for a total Project cost not to exceed \$2,130,155.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute Supplement No. 2 to the Local Agency Program Agreement ("Agreement") between the City of St. Petersburg, Florida and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") in an amount not to exceed \$275,000 for a total project cost not to exceed \$2,130,155 for additional funding of the construction activities for the US 92 (4th Street) Sidewalk Project ("Project"). 


