TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: Awarding a contract to MTM Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$1,810,010.50 for the construction of sidewalk, curb, ADA and signalization improvements along 4th Street North (SR 687/US 92) from 5th Avenue to 30th Avenue North; and providing an effective date. (Engineering Project Nos. 05107-110 and 05107-112; Oracle No. 10967, CP31144 and C120402).

EXPLANATION: The work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, services, and equipment necessary to construct approximately 6,675 linear feet of replacement concrete curb, 7,800 linear feet of resetting existing granite curb, 5,700 square yards of 4" thick concrete sidewalk, 3,200 square yards of 6" thick concrete driveway/sidewalk, 105 concrete sidewalk curb ramps, adjustment of 12 drainage inlets, 5 wind resistant mast arm traffic signal assemblies at the intersections of 22nd and 30th Avenues North; 2 traffic controller assemblies, 6,500 square yards of concrete hexagon imprint sidewalk to replace existing plain concrete sidewalk within Round Lake and Old Northeast National Register Historic Districts, and 200 square yards of resetting existing hexagon block sidewalk within these districts, sidewalks, pavement markings and traffic signs, traffic control and 2,000 square yards of sodding.

Bidders provided proposals under two categories. Group A work is eligible for 100% reimbursement under an existing State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreement, Group B work is City funded and provides for enhancements identified as priority by the 4th Street Business District plan, including center medians at 5th Avenue and 29th Avenue North, and hexagon imprinted sidewalks to enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety.

The contractor will begin work approximately ten consecutive calendar (10) days from written Notice to Proceed and is scheduled to complete the work within two hundred forty (240) consecutive calendar days thereafter. Bids were opened on October 16, 2008 and are tabulated as indicated below.

Administration recommends awarding this contract to MTM Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$1,810,010.50.

IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,810,010.50 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK, CURB, ADA AND SIGNALIZATION IMPROVEMENTS ALONG 4TH STREET NORTH (SR 687/US 92) FROM 5TH AVENUE TO 30TH AVENUE NORTH. (ENGINEERING PROJECT NOS. 05107-110 AND 05107-112; ORACLE NO. 10967, CP31144 AND C120402); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.




