SUBJECT: Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Amendment No. 1 to Task Order No. 06-01-AA/GC to the agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Ayres Associates, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$44,994.00 for construction phase services for 4th Street N. (SR687/US 92) between 5th and 30th Avenues – Sidewalk, Curb, ADA and Signalization Improvements, for a total amount of \$314,071.00 (Engineering Project No. 05107-110; FDOT FPN 406315-1-52-01; Oracle No. 10967)

EXPLANATION: On August 3, 2006, the City Council approved a Master Agreement with the professional consulting engineering firm of Ayres Associates, Inc. for engineering services for Storm Water Management, Roadway and Bridge Improvements (General Civil) Projects.

On November 16, 2006, Task Order No. 06-01-AA/GC, was approved in the amount of \$266,077.00, pertained to design phase services related to sidewalk, curb, ADA improvements along 4th Street N. and proposed mast arm traffic signal improvements at 22nd and 30th Avenues.

Revision No. 1 to Task Order No. 06-01-AA/GC was administratively approved in the amount of \$3,000.00 to perform additional structural design calculations in order to meet the FDOT's revised wind load design criteria for the proposed mast arms.

This Amendment No. 1 to Task Order Number 06-01-AA/GC provides for construction phase services consisting of: attendance at the pre-construction meeting; review of shop drawing submittals; responding to the contractor's requests for information and clarifications to the contract documents; interim job site visits; periodically up-dating and submitting As-Built drawings; and conducting final inspection with the contractor.

Administration recommends authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Amendment No. 1 to Task Order No. 06-01-AA/GC with Ayers Associates, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$44,994.00, bringing the total not to exceed amount to \$314,071.00.

IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$44,994.00 FOR CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES FOR 4TH STREET N. (SR687/US 92) BETWEEN 5TH AND 30TH AVENUES – SIDEWALK, CURB, ADA AND SIGNALIZATION IMPROVEMENTS, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$314,071.00 (ENGINEERING PROJECT NO. 05107-110; FDOT FPN 406315-1-52-01; ORACLE NO. 10967); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.




