TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair, and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a Joint Project Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Pinellas County in the estimated sum of \$173,998.13 for relocation of the City's Water Mains on the County's Bear Creek Channel Improvements Phase II Project, located between Rosati Lane and Hibiscus Avenue South; and providing an effective date. (County Project PID No. 922306) (Engineering Project No. 08083-111; Oracle No. 12212)

EXPLANATION: Pinellas County is proceeding with plans to construct road, bridge and drainage channel improvements along the Bear Creek Channel, located between Rosati Lane and Hibiscus Avenue South (County Project No. 922306). This project will require relocation of 300 linear feet of 6-inch existing City water main in the vicinity of the La Plaza bridge replacement. Relocation plans and specifications are being prepared by the City's consultant, Advanced Engineering & Design, Inc.

In order to accomplish the relocation work efficiently while minimizing expenses, the City's relocation plans can be included with the County's road and bridge construction plans for bidding, after execution of a Joint Project Agreement (JPA). The JPA requires the City to deposit into an interest bearing account, an amount equal to the engineer's estimate for the relocation work plus five percent (5%) as payment to the County for construction administration services, within thirty (30) days following the project bid opening. The County will use the funds for payment of the water main relocation and will reimburse the City in the event the cost of relocation is less than the funds provided. Should the bids exceed the engineer's estimate, the City has the option to reject the bids. If the City rejects the bids, the JPA would require the City to construct the water main relocation without delay to the County's contractor.

RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a Joint Project Agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Pinellas County in the estimated sum of \$173,998.13 for relocation of the City's Water Mains on the County's Bear Creek Channel Improvements Phase II Project, located between Rosati Lane and Hibiscus Avenue South; and providing an effective date. (County Project PID No. 922306) (Engineering Project No. 08083-111; Oracle No. 12212)




