**To: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council**

**Subject:** Renewing blanket purchase agreements with Alfred Conhagen, Inc. of Florida, Tampa Armature Works, Inc. d/b/a TAW Technical Field Services; Cardo USA, Inc. formerly ABS Pumps, Inc; Alttec Corporation; and Carter & Ver Planck for pumps, pump parts and repair services for the Water Resources Department at an estimated annual cost of \$675,000.

**Explanation:** On May 18, 2006 City Council approved multi-year agreements for pumps, pump parts and repair services effective through June 30, 2009. Alttec Corporation was subsequently awarded a contract for similar services under supplementary bid No. 6644 for specialized pump controllers and bubblers. Because the contract was under \$25,000 City Council approval was not required. Under the renewal of contract clause, the City reserves the right to extend the contract for two-one year periods if mutually agreeable. This is the first one-year renewal.

The city currently has over 400 pumps at the water reclamation facilities and lift stations. The vendors furnish, replace and install circulating, portable, stationary, centrifugal, diaphragm, hydraulic, propeller, injector, rotary submersible, surface-mounted sewage, sludge, sump and well pumps; as well as pump controllers and bubblers. The vendors also provide service and software support at these facilities.

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Water Resources Department, recommends for renewal:

These vendors have agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of IFB 6477 dated February 23, 2006 IFB 6644 dated May 25, 2007. This renewal will be effective through June 30, 2010.

**Cost/Funding/Assessment Information:** Funds have been previously appropriated in the Water Resources Operating Fund (4001), Water Resources Administration (4202045) and various capital improvement projects in the Water Resources Capital Project Fund (4003).

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS TO THE AGREEMENTS (BLANKET AGREEMENTS) WITH ALFRED CONHAGEN, INC. OF FLORIDA AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$225,000, TAMPA ARMATURE WORKS, INC. D/B/A TAW TECHNICAL FIELD SERVICES AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000, CARDO USA, INC. FORMERLY ABS PUMPS, INC. AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000, ALTTEC CORPORATION AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 AND CARTER & VER PLANCK, INC. AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FOR A TOTAL ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$675,000 FOR PUMPS, PUMP PARTS AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THESE TRANSACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2008, City Council approved the award of three-year agreements (Blanket Agreements) with two one-year renewal options to Alfred Conhagen, Inc. of Florida, Tampa Armature Works, Inc. d/b/a TAW Technical Field Services, ABS Pumps, now known as Cardo USA, Inc., Alttec Corporation and Carter & Ver Planck ("Vendors") pursuant to Bid No. 6477 dated February 23, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the first one-year renewal options of the Agreements with the Vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Vendors have agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of Bid No. 6477; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Water Resources Department, recommends approval of these renewals.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that one-year renewal options to the Agreements (Blanket Agreements) with Alfred Conhagen, Inc. of Florida at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$225,000, Tampa Armature Works, Inc. d/b/a TAW Technical Field Services at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$200,000, Cardo USA, Inc. formerly ABS Pumps, Inc. at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$150,000, Alttec Corporation at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$50,000

and Carter & Ver Planck, Inc. at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$50,000 for a total estimated annual cost not to exceed \$675,000 for pumps, pump parts and repair services for the Water Resources Department are hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate these transactions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these renewals will be effective through June 30, 2010.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
