Subject: Renewing an agreement with Professional Staffing ABTS Inc., dba Able Body Labor and Lumea Staffing, Inc. formerly E.S.S.I., Inc. for temporary staffing for city-wide use at an estimated annual amount of \$470,000.

Explanation: On June 7, 2007 City Council approved a two-year agreement for temporary staffing services effective through May 31, 2009. Under the renewal of contract clause, the city reserves the right to extend the agreement for two one-year periods if mutually agreeable. This is the first one-year renewal. The primary users are Water Resources, Sanitation, Transportation, City & Neighborhood Infrastructure, and Capital Improvements departments.

The vendors provide personnel, administration, recruitment, testing, screening and training for general labor, clerical, and other entry level temporary staffing positions.

The Purchasing Department in cooperation with the user departments recommends renewal:

The vendor has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of RFP No. 6589 dated March 15, 2007. The renewal will be effective from date of approval through May 31, 2010.

Cost/Funding/Assessment Information: Funds have been previously appropriated in the Sanitation Fund (4021) [\$143,000] Brush site account (4502301), Lot Clearing account (4502253) and Administrative account (4502237); Water Resources Operating Fund (4001) [\$184,000] accounts (4202117), (4202229), (4202045), (4202145), (4202169) (4202173) (4202177); and General Fund (0001) [\$45,000] Fire Department, Fire Administration account (1501485), and Fire Prevention account (1501493), Recreation Department, Sunshine Center account (1901661) and Stormwater Pavement & Traffic Operations Department accounts (4001265), (4001269), (4001273), (4001277); and in the Neighborhood & Citywide Infrastructure Capital Improvement Fund (3027) [\$30,000] for various capital projects.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FIRST ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS TO THE AGREEMENTS WITH PROFESSIONAL STAFFING-A.B.T.S., INC. D/B/A ABLE BODY LABOR AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$310,000 AND LUMEA STAFFING, INC. FORMERLY E.S.S.I., INC. AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$160,000 FOR A TOTAL ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$470,000 FOR TEMPORARY STAFFING FOR CITY-WIDE USE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THESE TRANSACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2007, City Council approved the award of two-year agreements with two one-year renewal options to Professional Staffing-A.B.T.S., Inc., d/b/a Able Body Labor and Lumea Staffing, Inc. formerly E.S.S.I., Inc. ("Vendors") for temporary staffing for city-wide use pursuant to RFP No. 6589 dated March 15, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the first one-year renewal options of the Agreements with the Vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Vendors have agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of Bid No. 6589; and

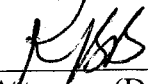
WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Water Resources, Sanitation, Transportation City & Neighborhood Infrastructure and Capital Improvements Departments, recommends approval of these renewals.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the first one-year renewal options to the Agreements with Professional Staffing-A.B.T.S., Inc., d/b/a Able Body Labor at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$310,000 and Lumea Staffing, Inc. at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$160,000 for a total estimated annual cost not to exceed \$470,000 for temporary staffing for city-wide use are hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate these transactions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these renewals will be effective through May 31, 2010.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
