**To: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council**

**Subject:** Renewing an agreement with G.A. Food Services of Pinellas County, Inc. d/b/a G.A. Food Service, Inc. for the Summer Food Service Program for the Recreation Department at an estimated annual amount of \$350,139.

**Explanation:** On May 15, 2008, City Council approved a one-year agreement for the Summer Food Service Program effective through May 31, 2009. Under the renewal of contract clause, the city reserves the right to extend the agreement for one one-year period if mutually agreeable. This is the first one-year renewal.

The vendor provides breakfast and lunch meals to children at 14 recreation sites, five days per week from June 8, 2009 through August 21, 2009.

The Purchasing Department in cooperation with the Recreation Department, recommends renewal:


G.A. Food Services of Pinellas County, Inc. d/b/a G.A. Food Service, Inc.....\$350,139

The vendor has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of IFB No.6717 dated April 2, 2008. The renewal will be effective through May 31, 2010. The program is funded by the Florida Department of Education, Food and Nutrition Management through a grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The menu, packaging, and delivery shall be in accordance with specifications provided by the Florida Department of Education, Food and Nutrition Management.

**Cost/Funding/Assessment Information:** Funds have been previously appropriated in the General Fund (0001), Recreation Department, Recreation Administration account (1901573) through a grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture provided by the Florida Department of Education, Food and Nutrition Management.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTION TO THE AGREEMENT WITH G. A. FOOD SERVICES OF PINELLAS COUNTY, INC. D/B/A G. A. FOOD SERVICE, INC. AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$350,139 FOR THE SUMMER FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM FOR THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THESE TRANSACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2008, City Council approved the award of a one-year agreement with a one-year renewal option to G. A. Food Services of Pinellas County, Inc. d/b/a G. A. Good Food Service, Inc. ("Vendor") for the Summer Food Service Program for the Recreation Department pursuant to Bid No. 6717 dated April 2, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the one-year renewal option of the Agreement with the Vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Vendor has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of Bid No. 6717; and


WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Recreation Department, recommends approval of this renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the one-year renewal option to the Agreement with G. A. Food Services of Pinellas County, Inc. d/b/a G. A. Food Service, Inc. at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$350,139 for the Summer Food Service Program for the Recreation Department is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this renewal will be effective through May 31, 2010.
