Subject: Accepting a proposal from PAW Materials, Inc. for digester tank repair services for the Water Resources Department a total cost of \$262,950.

Explanation: The Purchasing Department received eight proposals for digester tank repair services. The vendor will remove the damaged 95 foot diameter tank lids, remove the sludge and debris from the tanks, dewater the sludge and clean the interior of digester tanks 3 and 4 at the Northwest Water Reclamation Facility. The lids will be dismantled in sections and removed from the facility for processing and recycling by the vendor. Replacement lids for the tanks are currently being designed and will be procured separately.

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Water Resources Department, recommends for approval:

PAW Materials, Inc. has met the specifications, terms and conditions of RFP No. 6819 dated March 3, 2009. PAW is based in Hudson, Florida and has thirty employees. They have been incorporated since 1998 and have completed similar projects, including the demolition of the Town of Callahan Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the cooling tower demolition for GEA Progress Energy in Holiday, FL and have performed satisfactorily.
