SUBJECT: Awarding a contract to Kimmins Contracting Corporation in the amount of \$180,807.00 for the 54th Avenue South Slip-Lining Rehab of 54" RCP Sewer; rescinding an unencumbered appropriation in the Water Resources Capital Project Fund (4003) in the amount of \$250,000 from the SAN Bas. 1/4/10/15/18/20/29 Project (10114), approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$250,000 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Water Resources Capital Project Fund (4003) resulting from the rescission to the SAN 54 A/S Slip Line FY09 Project (12312); providing an effective date (Engineering Project No. 09020-111; Oracle No. 12312)

EXPLANATION: The work consists of furnishing all labor and equipment necessary to rehabilitate approximately 1,850 linear feet of 54-inch reinforced concrete pipe wastewater collection main along 54th Avenue South (Pinellas Bayway) from 34th Street to 41st Street South. Work includes insertion pit construction, pipeline cleaning, obstacle removal, closed circuit television inspection, insertion of 48" diameter centrifugally cast fiberglass reinforced polymer mortar liner pipe into the existing line, pipe liner joining, manhole sealing, grouting of the annular space, restoration of the insertion pit, and maintenance of traffic during construction. The pipeline is over 50 years old and has reached the end of its useful service life and is in need of replacement. The sliplining method of replacement will result in less inconvenience to motorists and reduced roadway restoration expenses as compared to open-cut pipeline replacement.

The contractor will begin work approximately ten (10) days from Notice to Proceed and is scheduled to be completed within sixty (60) calendar days thereafter. The bids were opened on April 16, 2009 and are tabulated as follows:




