Subject: Renewing blanket purchase agreements with Ring Power Corporation, Fleetpride Inc., Goodyear Rubber Products, Inc., Atlas Hydraulics, Inc., Walker Ford Co Inc. and 32 other companies for automotive parts and repair services for the Fleet Management Department at an estimated annual cost of \$2,029,435.

Explanation: On September 7, 2006 and November 29, 2007 City Council approved multi-year agreements for automotive parts and repair services effective through September 1, 2009. Under the renewal of contract clause, the city reserves the right to extend the contracts for one-two year period if mutually agreeable. This is the only renewal.

The vendors furnish and deliver replacement parts and provide repairs when requested to equipment such as automobiles, police cruisers, fire apparatus, light, medium and heavy duty trucks, backhoes, loaders, refuse vehicles, agricultural equipment, generators and compressors. The vendors provide variable discounts from manufacturers' price lists as well as hourly labor rates. The replacement parts may be installed by city mechanics or by vendors with in-house service capabilities. The vendors providing in-house repair service are utilized for specialized equipment repairs, warranty repairs and to offset workload during peak periods.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TWO-YEAR RENEWAL OPTION TO THE AGREEMENTS (BLANKET AGREEMENTS) WITH MULTIPLE VENDORS FOR THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMOTIVE PARTS AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$2,029,435; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THESE TRANSACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2007 City Council approved the award of two-year agreements (Blanket Agreements) with one two-year renewal option to Kenworth of Central Florida, Inc., Western Refuse & Recycling Equipment, Inc. RDK Truck Sales and Service, Inc. and Tampa Crane & Body, Inc. ("Vendors") for the purchase of automotive supplies and repair services pursuant to Bid No. 6642 dated June 28, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the two-year renewal options of the Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Vendors have agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of RFP No. 6488 and RFP No. 6642 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fleet Management and Sanitation Departments, recommends approval of these renewals.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the two-year renewal option of Agreements (Blanket Agreements) for automotive parts and repair services for the Fleet Management Department at a total estimated annual cost not to exceed of \$2,029,435 with the following Vendors in total estimated annual amounts not to exceed the individual amounts is hereby approved as follows:
