**To: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council**

**Subject:** Approving a three-year strategic partnering agreement with HD Supply Waterworks, LTD. (HDSW) for water and sewer supplies for the Water Resources Department at an annual cost of \$1,300,000.

**Explanation:** The Purchasing Department received two proposals for a strategic partnering agreement for water and sewer supplies.

HDSW will stock, furnish and deliver a complete line of water and sewer supplies including pipe, hydrants, valves, fittings, assemblies, tools, specialty equipment and technology services. These items will be stocked and distributed from Purchasing's Consolidated Warehouse.

HDSW will also provide value-added services including: locally stocking and managing a minimum inventory based on usage prescribed by the City; providing technical product support; providing access to its inventory database including purchasing transactions; delivering all items on the inventory list within three days after receipt of order; utilizing e-business strategies to streamline transactions; allowing the return of surplus inventory for full credit; assigning resources for a minimum of four hours per month to assist warehouse staff in maintaining ordering parameters, forecasting, and monitoring stock levels to prevent stock-out; and collaborating with city staff to ensure effective communication, training and testing for new initiatives and products.

The proposals were evaluated by a cross-functional team from Engineering, Water Resources and Purchasing based on criteria such as service capability, management capability, warehousing capability and cost

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Engineering and Water Resources departments, recommends:


HDSW has met the requirements of RFP 6801 dated April 1, 2009. They have been in the water, sewer and gas production business for over 50 years. They are the single largest water industry organization in the United States with over 230 locations nationwide, and operate 22 branches in the state of Florida with over \$20 million worth of inventory. This agreement will be serviced through the Tampa branch. HDSW has similar agreements with Orlando Utility Commission, Jacksonville Electric Authority and Water, Gainesville Regional Utilities, City of Apopka and City of Leesburg. They have provided excellent service for the City in the past.

**Cost/Funding/Assessment Information:** Funds have been previously appropriated in the Water Resources Operating Fund (4001), Water Resources Department (4202109, 4202113, 4202117, 4202121, 4202125, 4202129 and 4202145), as well as various capital improvement projects in the Water Resources Capital Projects Fund (4003).

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL AND APPROVING THE AWARD OF A THREE YEAR STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT TO HD SUPPLY WATERWORKS, LTD., FOR WATER AND SEWER SUPPLIES FOR THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT AT AN ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$1,300,000; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department received two proposals for a three year strategic partnership agreement for water and sewer supplies for the Water Resources Department pursuant to RFP No. 6801 dated April 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS, HD Supply Waterworks, LTD., has met the terms and conditions of RFP No. 6801; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Water Resources Department and Engineering Department, has reviewed the proposals and recommends this award.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the proposal and award of a three year strategic partnership agreement to HD Supply Waterworks, LTD., for water and sewer supplies for the Water Resources Department at an annual cost not to exceed \$1,300,000 is hereby approved and the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
