SUBJECT: Awarding a contract to Duncan Seawall, Dock and Boatlift, Inc. in the amount of \$104,420.00 for the Municipal Marina Mooring Piling Replacement – FY 2008 (Engineering Project No. 08057-117; Oracle Nos. 11666 and 12113)

EXPLANATION: The work consists of furnishing all labor, material, services, and equipment to remove and replace selected deteriorated mooring piling within the central and south yacht basins of the Municipal Marina. Replacement piling will be new pressure treated timber between 30 to 50 feet in length. The contract quantities include 47 new single piles and two new 3-pile mooring dolphins. Work also includes removing and resetting 21 existing single piles, and removal and replacement of selected areas of deteriorated wharf structure and deck at the Sailing Center. The bid add alternate provides for substituting long-life recycled polymer composite planks for pressure treated lumber for the Sailing Center wharf reconstruction.

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DUNCAN SEAWALL, DOCK AND BOATLIFT, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$104,420.00 FOR THE MUNICIPAL MARINA MOORING PILING REPLACEMENT – FY 2008 (ENGINEERING PROJECT NO. 08057-117; ORACLE NOS. 11666 AND 12113) AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE:

WHEREAS, bids were opened on May 7, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the low bidder, Duncan Seawall, Dock and Boatlift, Inc. has satisfactorily performed other similar projects in the past; and

WHEREAS, the contractor will begin work approximately sixty (60) consecutive calendar days from written Notice to Proceed; and

WHEREAS, the work consists of furnishing all labor, material, services, and equipment to remove and replace selected deteriorated mooring piling within the central and south yacht basins of the Municipal Marina. Replacement Piling will be new pressure treated timber between 30 to 50 feet in length. The contract quantities include 47 new single piles and two new 3-pile mooring dolphins. 
