SUBJECT:

Accepting funding from the Coordinated Child Care of Pinellas, Inc. ("CCC") in the amount of \$3,533 for the Teen Arts, Sports and Cultural Opportunities (TASCO) Digital Photography Program; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute an agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with CCC; approving a supplemental appropriation of \$3,533 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues to the Recreation Department TASCO TECH FY09 project; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION:

Coordinated Child Care ("CCC") has awarded funding to the City of St. Petersburg Recreation Department to provide the TASCO Digital Photography Program. This program is a 7 week, 30 hour course designed to introduce teens to Digital Photography and Computer Graphics. Participants use digital cameras to complete assignments to include composition techniques, creating emotion, using a flash creatively, and creating a photo essay. Portrait and studio lighting, printing, mounting, and framing techniques are also taught to participants. Adobe Photoshop CS4 is used to teach photo editing, restoration, and manipulation. A "Family and Friends Night" will be held at the close of the program to recognize and showcase the class accomplishments.

RECOMMENDATION:

Administration recommends this Council adopt the attached resolution accepting funding from the Coordinated Child Care of Pinellas, Inc. ("CCC") in the amount of \$3,533 for the TASCO Digital Photography Program; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute an agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with CCC; approving a supplemental appropriation of \$3,533 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date.



SUBJECT:

Accepting a grant from the Coordinated Child Care of Pinellas, Inc. ("CCC") in the amount of \$813,294 for the Teen Arts, Sports and Cultural Opportunities (TASCO) Center Based Teen Programs; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute an agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with CCC; approving a supplemental appropriation of \$813,294 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues to the Recreation Department TASCO FY09 project; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION:

Coordinated Child Care ("CCC") has awarded a tenth year of funding for a grant to the City of St. Petersburg Recreation Department to provide TASCO Center Based Teen Programs which includes the TASCO Summer Teen Camp and the Middle School Before and After School Program. Funds for this grant are provided by the Juvenile Welfare Board of Pinellas County (JWB) which in previous years contracted directly with the City of St. Petersburg Recreation Department to provide programs. The funding is for the period from June 3, 2009 to September 30, 2009.

TASCO Summer Teen Camp provides summer teen camp programs at twelve recreation sites: Shore Acres, Gladden Park, Frank Pierce, Lake Vista, Campbell Park, Childs Park, Walter Fuller, Wildwood, J.W. Cate, Camp Redbird, Roberts and Willis S. Johns. TASCO Summer Teen Camps are 11 weeks long from June 8 until August 24, 2009. St. Petersburg continues to be a leader in providing programming for teens that stimulates and develops youth. Youth completing the sixth grade through ninth grade are eligible to participate in the camps.

TASCO Center Based Teen Programs also provides Middle School Before and After School programs at eleven Recreation Centers: Campbell Park, Childs Park, J.W. Cate, Shore Acres, Walter Fuller, Wildwood, Willis S. Johns, Frank Pierce, Lake Vista, Roberts, and Gladden. This grant funds 3 full time workers and 14 part-time workers to implement programming. Five core areas designed by the teens for programming include school readiness, parent involvement, leadership development, community service, powerful and productive adult interaction. Drug, alcohol and tobacco use prevention, building resiliency, and reducing risk-taking behaviors will be the main program focus.

RECOMMENDATION:

Administration recommends this Council adopt the attached resolution accepting a grant from the Coordinated Child Care of Pinellas, Inc. ("CCC") in the amount of \$813,294 for the TASCOCenter Based Teen Programs; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute an agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with CCC; approving a supplemental appropriation of \$813,294 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date.


