TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: A resolution accepting a grant in the amount of \$190,000 from the U.S. Department of Labor for the Summer Youth Intern Program ("Grant"); approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$110,000 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from these additional revenues to the Community Affairs Department; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the Grant; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION: The City has previously operated a Summer Youth Program (SYIP) for over a decade, that was totally funded through the City's General Fund, Non-departmental funding. However, due to budget cuts brought on due to tax reform in FY 2007, the funding was severely reduced from \$300,000 to \$30,000. The SYIP program was discontinued in September, 2007, because of the lack of adequate funding for the program. Subsequently, in 2008 and 2009, the City funded \$30,000 to provide stipends for 30 youth (ages 14-16), to participate in a Summer Career Institute, for workforce training, which is administered by WorkNet Pinellas.

In 2008, a Federal Earmark was requested to replace the local funding for the SYIP. That request was granted in the 2008 Federal Omnibus Bill, approved on March 10, 2009, and the City has been approved to receive \$190,000 for the SYIP.


City Council has previously accepted and appropriated a pre-award from the Grant in the amount of \$80,000. The \$110,000 balance of the Grant requires a supplemental appropriation to the Community Affairs Department.

RECOMMENDATION: The administration recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution accepting a grant in the amount of \$190,000 from the U.S. Department of Labor for the Summer Youth Intern Program ("Grant"); approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$110,000 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from these additional revenues to the Community Affairs Department; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the Grant; and providing an effective date.



A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$190,000 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR THE SUMMER YOUTH INTERN PROGRAM (“GRANT”); APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$110,000 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND (0001) RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL REVENUES TO THE COMMUNITY AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE GRANT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide its youth with job opportunities during the summer months; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Labor has offered the City a grant in the amount of \$190,000 (“Grant”) to fund the City’s Summer Youth Intern Program (“Program”); and

WHEREAS, the Grant will provide the City with funds to carry out its Program; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept the Grant to fund the Program; and

WHEREAS, City Council has previously accepted and appropriated a pre-award from the Grant in the amount of \$80,000; and

WHEREAS, a supplemental appropriation of the balance of the Grant from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from these additional revenues to the Community Affairs Department is required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that a grant in the amount of \$190,000 from the Grant for the Summer Youth Intern Program (“Grant”) is accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund resulting from these additional revenues, the following supplemental appropriation:

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL AND APPROVING THE AWARD OF AN AGREEMENT TO BOLEY CENTERS, INC. FOR MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE SUMMER YOUTH INTERN PROGRAM FOR THE COMMUNITY AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$190,000; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department received four bids for management services for the Summer Youth Intern Program for the Community Affairs Department pursuant to RFP No. 6828 dated April 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Boley Centers, Inc. has met the terms and conditions of RFP No. 6828; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Community Affairs Department, has reviewed the proposals and recommends this award; and

WHEREAS, City Council has previously authorized the award of an agreement to Boley Centers, Inc. in the amount of \$80,000 funded by a pre-award of the U.S. Department of Labor grant ("Grant") that will fund the program; and

WHEREAS, the full Grant in the amount of \$190,000 has been awarded to the City and it is the intent of this resolution to increase the amount of the previously awarded agreement to \$190,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the proposal and award of an agreement to Boley Centers, Inc. for management services for the Summer Youth Intern Program for the Community Affairs Department at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$190,000 is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this agreement will be effective from the date of award through the end of the 2009 summer program.
