**TO:** The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

**SUBJECT:** Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Task Order No. 08-02-GH/W to the agreement between the City of St. Petersburg and Greeley and Hansen, LLC in the amount not to exceed \$73,000 for construction phase services for the relocation of the City's 36" Water Transmission Main at Allen's Creek; authorizing a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$108,000 from the unappropriated balance of the Water Resources Capital Projects Fund (4003) to the WRL US19 Whitney/SR 60 Allen's Creek FY 07 Project (11381); and providing an effective date. (Engineering Project No. 06100-211; Oracle No. 11381)

**EXPLANATION:** On November 21, 2008, the City Council approved a Master Agreement with the professional consulting engineering firm of Greeley and Hansen LLC, for engineering services related to the design and construction of Potable Water Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Projects.

The City's 36" Water Transmission Main was constructed in the 1930s, within dedicated easements, and delivers water from the Cosme Water treatment plant in Hillsborough County, along with a separate 48" diameter main constructed in the 1960s. A 230 foot long segment of 36" diameter pipe beneath Allen's Creek was originally constructed near the creek bottom. This section of pipe needs to be lowered to protect the pipe from potential impact damage from boat traffic using the waterway.

Task Order No. 04-09-GH/W, was administratively approved on May 11, 2007 in the amount of \$87,801, and pertained to final design, permitting, and bidding services for the relocation project.

The scope of work for the inspection services includes, but is not limited to, pre-construction meeting, construction phase requests for information, review of shop drawings, progress meeting attendance, resident inspection services, and preliminary and final punch list preparation, and as-built drawing preparation for the relocation of the City's 36" Water Transmission Main at Allen's Creek.

Administration recommends authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute Task Order No. 08-02-GH/W with Greeley and Hansen LLC, in the amount not to exceed \$73,000, bringing the total Greeley and Hansen project design and construction inspection cost to a not to exceed amount to \$160,801. City costs for administration, construction inspection and a contingency allowance total \$35,000; these costs in addition to Task Order sum of \$73,000 bring the required supplemental appropriation to \$108,000.

**COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION:** Funding will be available in the Water Resources Capital Projects Fund (4003) with a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$108,000 from the Water Resources Capital Projects Fund (4003) to the WRL US19 Whitney/SR 60 Allen's Creek FY 07 Project (11381).

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE TASK ORDER NO. 08-02-GH/W TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG AND GREELEY AND HANSEN IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$73,000 FOR CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE CITY'S 36" WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN AT ALLEN'S CREEK; AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$108,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE WATER RESOURCES CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND (4003) TO THE WRL US 19 WHITNEY/SR 60 ALLEN'S CREEK FY07 PROJECT (11381) (ENGINEERING PROJECT NO. 06100-211; ORACLE NO. 11381); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.




