**TO:** The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair, and Members of City Council

**SUBJECT:** A resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") in the amount of \$914,999 ("Grant") for the City's Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program ("HPRP") and to execute a Grant agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate acceptance of the Grant, approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$914,999 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the HPRP Fund (1017) resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date.

**EXPLANATION:** During the May 7, 2009 meeting, Council approved the City's submission of a Substantial Amendment to the City's FY 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan to HUD to receive funding for the City's Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program ("Program"). The Program was allocated \$914,999 in funding ("Grant") from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") to assist the City with homeless prevention and rapid re-housing of affected persons. All funding allocated by HUD must be expended within 3 years, and 60% of funding allocated must be expended within 2 years after the execution of an Agreement between HUD and the City.

HUD has submitted to the City the Agreement which the City must execute prior to implementing the Program. Administration is requesting a supplemental appropriation of \$914,999 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the HPRP Fund (1017) resulting from the Grant to fund the Program.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Administration recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") in the amount of \$914,999 ("Grant") for the City's Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program ("HPRP") and to execute a Grant agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate acceptance of the Grant, approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$914,999 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the HPRP Fund (1017) resulting from these additional revenues; and providing an effective date.

**COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION:**

Revenues of \$914,999 will be received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and will be appropriated in 0821089 NS.Housing Administration, from the increase in the unappropriated fund balance of the HPRP Fund (1017) resulting from these additional revenues.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (“HUD”) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$914,999 (“GRANT”) FOR THE CITY’S HOMELESS PREVENTION AND RAPID RE-HOUSING PROGRAM (“HPRP”) AND TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT, APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$914,999 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE HPRP FUND (1017) RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL REVENUES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2009 City Council approved the City’s current Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (“HPRP”) and authorized the Administration to submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”); and

WHEREAS, the City has established that it will administer the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program; and

WHEREAS, HUD has approved a grant to the City in the amount of \$914,999 (“Grant”) to fund the HPRP; and

WHEREAS, 60% of HPRP funding received by the City must be expended within 2-years after the execution of an Agreement between HUD and the City; and

WHEREAS, 100% of the HPRP grant funds must be expended within 3 years of the execution of an Agreement between HUD and the City; and

WHEREAS, \$914,999 in funding from this program is committed to funding the following:

- Financial Assistance for Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing; and
- Housing Relocation and Stabilization Services for Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing; and
- Data Collection and Evaluation; and
- Program Administration.

WHEREAS, acceptance of the Grant and approval of a supplemental appropriation of \$914,999 of the Grant funds is necessary to implement the HPRP.




NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and urban Development ("HUD") in the amount of \$914,999 ("Grant") for the City's Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program ("HPRP") and to execute a Grant Agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate acceptance of the Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Fund (1017) resulting from these additional revenues, the following supplemental appropriation:
