**Subject:** Approving the donation of an aerial rescue vehicle valued at \$7,500 to St. Petersburg College.

**Explanation:** It is recommended that this 1989 Pierce Lance E4988 aerial rescue vehicle be donated to the St. Petersburg College Fire Academy. This equipment will be used for the Aerial Operator training program at the academy.


The vehicle is equipped with a 55 foot aerial straight ladder, 500 gallon water tank and 1500 gallon per minute water pump. The vehicle's current odometer reading is 131,250 miles and it has exceeded its useful service life. The estimated value of this unit is \$7,500.


St. Petersburg College will be responsible for transporting the unit as well as accepting all liability and maintenance for the vehicle.

**Cost/Funding/Assessment Information:** This donation represents a minimal cost impact. History indicates the city would realize approximately \$7,500 for the sale of this equipment.

WHEREAS, the City owns a 1989 Pierce Lance E4988 aerial rescue vehicle that has exceeded its useful service life; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to donate the vehicle to St. Petersburg College; and

WHEREAS, St. Petersburg College will be responsible for transporting the unit and all liability and maintenance of the vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the donation of an aerial rescue vehicle valued at \$7,500 to St. Petersburg College is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.
