Subject: A resolution approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$21,103 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from the payment in lieu of taxes paid by the St. Petersburg Housing Authority for the Dr. Carter G. Woodson African American Museum ("Museum"), to Midtown Economic Development (3301945) to provide funds to the Museum for use in accordance with an agreement with the City; and providing an effective date.

Explanation: The City has received a payment in lieu of taxes ("PILOT") in the amount of \$21,103 from the St. Petersburg Housing Authority for the Dr. Carter G. Woodson African American Museum ("Museum"). On May 7, 2009, City Council approved a request from Councilmember Karl Nurse to provide the funds from the PILOT to the Museum for use in accordance with an agreement between the City and the Museum.

Located one block from 22nd Street South, the Dr. Carter G. Woodson African American Museum plays an important role in the revitalization of the mid-town community. The museum is a point of interest with exhibitions rich in local and national history and educational programming for St. Petersburg residents and area visitors.


Over the next year and beyond, the museum seeks to involve a large number of youth groups in its programming, especially targeting middle and high school students whom are currently under represented museum visitors.

Recommendation: Administration recommends approval of the attached resolution approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$21,103 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) resulting from the payment in lieu of taxes paid by the St. Petersburg Housing Authority for the Dr. Carter G. Woodson African American Museum ("Museum"), to Midtown Economic Development (3301945) to provide funds to the Museum for use in accordance with an agreement with the City; and providing an effective date.



A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,103 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND (0001) RESULTING FROM THE PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TAXES PAID BY THE ST. PETERSBURG HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR THE DR. CARTER G. WOODSON AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSEUM ("MUSEUM"), TO MIDTOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (3301945) TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO THE MUSEUM FOR USE IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has received a payment in lieu of taxes ("PILOT") in the amount of \$21,103 from the St. Petersburg Housing Authority for the Dr. Carter G. Woodson African American Museum ("Museum"); and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2009, City Council approved a request from Councilmember Karl Nurse to provide the funds from the PILOT to the Museum for use in accordance with an agreement between the City and the Museum; and

WHEREAS, the Dr. Carter G. Woodson African American Museum plays an important role in the revitalization of the Midtown community, and is a point of interest with exhibitions rich in local and national history and educational programming for St. Petersburg residents and area visitors; and

WHEREAS, over the next year and beyond, the museum seeks to involve a large number of youth groups in its programming, especially targeting middle and high school students who are currently under-represented museum visitors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of St. Petersburg, Florida that there is hereby approved from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional funds, the following supplemental appropriation for FY 2009:
