Subject: Renewing a blanket purchase agreement with Prison Rehabilitation Industries and Diversified Enterprises, Inc. (PRIDE) for tire repairs and recapping services for the Fleet Management department at an estimated annual cost of \$311,120.

Explanation: On July 24, 2008 City Council approved a multi-year agreement for tire repairs and recapping effective through August 31, 2009. The agreement is in accordance with the Florida State Use Law Program, Statute 946.515 which encourages the State and its political subdivisions to purchase supplies and services from prison/rehabilitative industries without bidding. Under the renewal of contract clause, the city reserves the right to extend the contract for three one-year periods if mutually agreeable. This is the first one-year renewal.

The vendors provide tire recapping and repairs for sanitation trucks, large dump trucks and catch basin cleaners. These tires are used only on rear axles. Recapped tires deliver approximately 75 percent of the tread life and are about 35 percent of the cost of a new tire. Fleet Management can recap a tire casing up to five times before a new tire is required.

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fleet Management Department, recommends for renewal:


PRIDE Enterprises, Inc.....\$311,120


The vendor has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of the Agreement dated July 28, 2009. This renewal will be effective through August 31, 2010.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING RENEWAL OF AN AGREEMENT (BLANKET AGREEMENT) WITH PRISON REHABILITATIVE INDUSTRIES AND DIVERSIFIED ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR TIRE AND RECAPPING SERVICES FOR THE FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$311,120 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FLORIDA STATE USE LAW PROGRAM (FLORIDA STATUTE 946.515); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2008 City Council approved the award a one-year agreement with three one-year renewal options to Prison Rehabilitative Industries and Diversified Enterprises, Inc. ("PRIDE") pursuant to the Florida State Use Program (Florida Statute 946.515) for tire and recapping services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the first one-year renewal option of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, PRIDE has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fleet Management Department, recommends approval of this renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the renewal of the agreement (Blanket Agreement) with Prison Rehabilitative Industries and Diversified Enterprises, Inc. for tire repairs and recapping services for the Fleet Management Department at an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$311,120 in accordance with the Florida State Use Law Program (Florida Statute 946.515) is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this renewal will be effective through August 31, 2010.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
