
SUBJECT: A resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a one year contract between the School Board of Pinellas County, Florida and the City of St Petersburg for the continuation of the School Resource Officer Program in the public school system of Pinellas County, and to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION: The City of St. Petersburg and the School Board of Pinellas County, Florida entered into a one year contract whereas the St. Petersburg Police Department will provide nine school resource officers at four high schools and five middle schools during the 2009-2010 school year. A school resource officer will be located at Gibbs High, Lakewood High, Northeast High, St. Petersburg High, Azalea Middle, Bay Pointe Middle, John Hopkins Middle, Meadowlawn Middle, and Tyrone Middle Schools. The School Board of Pinellas County, Florida shall pay the City of St Petersburg, the sum of \$49,011.50 for each school resource officer during the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. The total contract amount is \$441,103.50. Security services provided by the St. Petersburg Police Department at school functions occurring after regular school hours shall be paid in accordance with the St. Petersburg Police Department's salary policy and procedures. The contract is in effect from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

RECOMMENDATION: The administration recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a one year contract between the School Board of Pinellas County, Florida ("Board") and the City of St Petersburg for the continuation of the School Resource Officer ("SRO") program in the public school system of Pinellas County, and to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and providing an effective date

COST/FUNDING INFORMATION: Funds for the school resource officers have been previously appropriated in the FY09 Operating Budget, General fund (0001) Police Department Youth Resources (140 1389).

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A ONE YEAR CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$441,103.50 BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA AND THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM OF PINELLAS COUNTY, AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of St Petersburg and the School Board of Pinellas County, Florida entered into a one year contract agreement that will allow the St. Petersburg Police Department ("Department") to place nine school resource officers into four high schools and five middle schools; and

WHEREAS, the School Board of Pinellas County, Florida shall pay the City of St Petersburg, the sum of \$49,011.50 per school resource officer during the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. The total contract amount is \$441,103.50; and

WHEREAS, a school resource officer will be located at Gibbs High, Lakewood High, Northeast High, St. Petersburg High, Azalea Middle, Bay Pointe Middle, John Hopkins Middle, Meadowlawn Middle, and Tyrone Middle Schools; and

WHEREAS, security services provided by the Department at school functions occurring after regular school hours shall be paid in accordance with the Department's salary policy and procedures; and


WHEREAS, the contract is in effect from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept a one year contract between the School Board of Pinellas County, Florida and the City of St Petersburg for the continuation of the School Resource Officer Program in the public school system of Pinellas County, and to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.
