Subject: Renewing an agreement with The Budd Group, Inc. for security guard services for the Sanitation and Fleet Management departments at an estimated annual amount of \$142,380.

Explanation: On September 1, 2005 City Council approved a two-year blanket purchase agreement for security guard services utilizing Pinellas County Contract No. 034-455-B. The initial term was effective through September 30, 2007. Under the renewal of contract clause, the city reserves the right to extend the agreement for three one-year periods if mutually agreeable. This is the third and final one-year renewal option which will be effective through September 30, 2010.

The vendor provides non-armed uniformed security guard services. The hours of coverage for the Sanitation complex are 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m. Monday to Friday and 24 hour coverage for weekends and holidays. The hours of coverage for the Fleet complex are 12:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m. Monday to Friday, weekends from 3:30 p.m. Saturday to 7:00 a.m. Monday and 24 hour coverage for holidays. The locations covered are for each department's main complex overseeing buildings and vehicles with one guard at each location.

The Purchasing Department in cooperation with the Sanitation and Fleet Management departments recommends for renewal utilizing Pinellas County Contract No. 034-455-B:

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE THIRD ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTION OF AN AGREEMENT (BLANKET AGREEMENT) WITH THE BUDD GROUP, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$142,380 FOR SECURITY GUARD SERVICES FOR THE SANITATION AND FLEET MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2005 City Council approved a two-year Agreement (Blanket Agreement) with three one-year renewal options with The Budd Group, Inc. ("Vendor") for security guard services for the Sanitation and Fleet Management Departments utilizing Pinellas County Contract No. 034-455-B; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2007 City Council approved the first one-year renewal option of the Agreement with the Vendor; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2008 City Council approved the second one-year renewal option of the Agreement with the Vendor; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the third one-year renewal option of the Agreement with the Vendor; and

WHEREAS, the Vendor has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of Pinellas County Contract No. 034-455-B; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Sanitation and Fleet Management Departments, recommends approval of this renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that approval of the third one-year renewal option to the Agreement (Blanket Agreement) with The Budd Group, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$142,380 for security guard services for the Sanitation and Fleet Management Departments is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this renewal will be effective through September 30, 2010.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
