TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: A resolution rescinding an unencumbered appropriation in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023) in the amount of \$42,809.00 from a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership ("Rescission"); approving the transfer of \$42,809.00 from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023), resulting from this Rescission to the General Fund (0001); approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$42,809.00 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) to the Police Department, Fiscal Support (140-1389); and providing an effective date.


EXPLANATION: The City has previously been awarded a Bureau of Justice Assistance grant for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership for the period of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2010, accepted by Council in Resolution 2008-546. Grant funds are for the purchase new bulletproof vests for the Police Department's sworn personnel. The department requires all new police officers to purchase a bulletproof vest and current police officers can replace their bulletproof vest every three years. The department reimburses the police officers for vest purchases as long as the purchase meets the criteria outlined the Police Benevolent Association contract. The grant requires a 50 percent match of local funds. Council Resolution 2008-546 erroneously appropriated \$97,388 to the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023), which included the 50 percent match. This resolution is to move the required match to the department's operating budget, which has already been charged for the vests.

RECOMMENDATION: The administration recommends adoption of the attached resolution rescinding an unencumbered appropriation in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023) in the amount of \$42,809.00 from a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership ("Rescission"); approving the transfer of \$42,809.00 from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023), resulting from this Rescission to the General Fund (0001); approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$42,809.00 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001) to the Police Department, Fiscal Support (140-1389); and providing an effective date


COST/FUNDING INFORMATION: Funds have been previously appropriated in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023), from a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership. Unencumbered appropriations in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023) in the amount of \$42,809.00 from the Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant will need to be rescinded and a transfer of \$42,809.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023) to the General Fund (0001); and a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$42,809.00 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), to the Police Department, Fiscal Support (140-1389).

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (1023) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,809.00 FROM A BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP (“RESCISSION”); APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF \$42,809.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (1023), RESULTING FROM THIS RESCISSION TO THE GENERAL FUND (0001); APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,809.00 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND (0001) TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FISCAL SUPPORT (140-1389); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the City has previously been awarded a Bureau of Justice Assistance grant (“Grant”) for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership for the period of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2010, which was accepted by Council in Resolution No. 2008-546; and

Whereas, the grant requires a 50 percent match of local funds; and

Whereas, Council Resolution No. 2008-546 appropriated \$97,388 in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023), which erroneously included the 50 percent match; and

Whereas, the purpose of this resolution is to remove the amount of the required match from the appropriation contained in Council Resolution No. 2008-546 and transfer that amount to the Police Department’s operating budget, which has already been charged for the vests.



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the unencumbered appropriation in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (1023) in the amount of \$42,809 from the Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant is hereby rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there are hereby approved the following supplemental appropriations from the unappropriated balance of their respective funds for FY 2009:
