Subject: Awarding a contract to Steve's Excavating & Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$657,000.00 for Shore Acres Stormwater Vaults. (Engineering Project No.05066-110; Oracle No.10489).

Explanation: The Purchasing Department received ten bids for Shore Acres Stormwater Vaults (see below). The contractor will furnish all labor, material, services, and equipment necessary to construct 9 (nine) stormwater back flow prevention vaults at prioritized locations to reduce routine tidal flooding along low-lying streets, and provide water quality improvement benefits, in the Shore Acres Neighborhood. Each vault includes a sediment sump, trash screen, and backflow prevention check valve.

Overall, there are 13 existing stormwater vaults in the Shore Acres Neighborhood, and 47 outfalls which are candidates for retrofitting with stormwater vaults. A SWFWMD cooperative funding agreement, approved by City Council on November 1, 2007 provides for reimbursement of 50% of eligible project costs, including the construction cost.

Work includes: nine stormwater vaults with check valves; 46 linear feet of sanitary sewer relocation, one sanitary manhole, 80 LF of 8" force main relocation; 240 linear feet of water main relocation; 90 square yards of heavy duty roadway restoration; 500 SF of sidewalk restoration; 4,000 SF of driveway restoration; and 20,500 SF of sodding.

The contractor will begin work approximately ten (10) days from Notice to Proceed and is scheduled to complete work within two hundred and ten (210) consecutive calendar days thereafter. Bids were opened on October 13, 2009, and are tabulated as follows:

The lowest responsive bidder, Steve's Excavating & Paving, Inc. has satisfactorily performed similar work for Pasco County and the cities of New Port Richey and Safety Harbor. Principals of the firm are Cathy Sarnago, President; Steve Sarnago, Vice President.

Recommendation: Administration recommends awarding this contract to Steve's Excavating & Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$657,000.00

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID AND APPROVING THE AWARD OF AN AGREEMENT WITH STEVE'S EXCAVATING & PAVING, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NINE (9) STORMWATER VAULTS IN THE SHORE ACRES NEIGHBORHOOD AT AN ESTIMATED TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$657,000; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department received nine bids for the construction of 9 (nine) stormwater back flow prevention vaults in the Shore Acres Neighborhood pursuant to Bid No. 6893 dated September 18, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Steve's Excavating & Paving, Inc. has met the specifications and requirements of Bid No. 6893; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends approval of this award.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the bid and award of an agreement to Steve's Excavating & Paving, Inc. for construction of nine (9) stormwater vaults in the Shore Acres Neighborhood at an estimated total cost not to exceed \$657,000 is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
