**To: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council**

**Subject:** Approving the purchase of a replacement fire pumper for the Fire Department from The Sutphen Corporation at a total cost of \$364,623.

**Explanation:** This purchase is being made from City of Boca Raton RFP No. 2008-087.

The vendor will furnish and deliver one unit with extruded aluminum framing, heavy-duty chassis, Allison EVS3000 6 speed automatic transmission, 425 hp diesel engine and 65-gallon fuel tank. The additional equipment includes a Smart Power Generator package; intercom system with radio interface; and 30 gallon foam tank with eductor and gauge. The package also includes 24" front bumper extension; 17" disc brakes and upgrades to lighting and severe duty air conditioning.

The new unit has a life expectancy of ten years and will be stationed at the Palmetto Station No. 3. It will replace a 13 year-old unit that will be used as a reserve unit.

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fire Department, recommends for award utilizing City of Boca Raton RFP No. 2008-087:





WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-234(e) of the City Code the City is permitted to utilize competitively bid contracts of other governmental entities when it is in the best interest of the City; and


WHEREAS, The Sutphen Corporation has met the specifications, terms and conditions of Boca Raton RFP No. 2008-087; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Fire Department, recommends approval of this award.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the award of an agreement to The Sutphen Corporation for the purchase of a replacement fire pumper at a total cost not to exceed \$364,623 for the Fire Department utilizing City of Boca Raton RFP No. 2008-087 is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction.
