Subject: Renewing a blanket purchase agreement with Universal Signs & Accessories, Inc. for traffic signs for the Stormwater Pavement and Traffic Operations Department at an estimated annual cost of \$124,600.

Explanation: On October 16, 2008, City Council approved a one year blanket purchase agreement for traffic signs effective through October 17, 2009. This purchase was made from Pinellas County Contract No. 067-0446-B. This renewal request which will be effective through September 17, 2011.

The vendor provides sign blanks, posts and related hardware for various street signage including traffic, traffic calming for neighborhoods, parking, bike trails, school zone enhancements and street names. Signage requirements include upgrades, routine replacement and damaged or missing signage replacement.

The Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Stormwater Pavement and Traffic Operations Department, recommends approval of this renewal utilizing Pinellas County Contract No. 067-0446-B:

Universal Signs & Accessories, Inc. has agreed to hold the terms and conditions of Pinellas County Contract No. 067-0446-B dated May 18, 2007. This purchase is made in accordance with Section 2-234 (e) of the City Code which authorizes the Mayor or his designee to purchase supplies from a competitively bid proposal or contract secured by State, County or municipal government.

Cost/Funding/Assessment Information: Funds have been previously appropriated in the General Fund (0001), Stormwater Pavement and Traffic Operation Department, Traffic Sign Fabrication (4001269) and Traffic Sign Installation (4001273).

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF AN AGREEMENT (BLANKET AGREEMENT) WITH UNIVERSAL SIGNS AND ACCESSORIES, INC. FOR TRAFFIC SIGNS AT AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$124,600 FOR THE STORMWATER PAVEMENT AND TRAFFIC OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2008 City Council approved a one-year Agreement (Blanket Agreement) with one two-year renewal option to Universal Signs And Accessories, Inc. for traffic signs utilizing Pinellas County Contract No. 07-0446-B dated May 18, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to exercise the renewal option of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Universal Signs And Accessories, Inc. has agreed to uphold the terms and conditions of Pinellas County Contract No. 067-0446-B; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Department, in cooperation with the Stormwater Pavement and Traffic Operations Department, recommends renewal of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the renewal of an agreement (Blanket Agreement) with Universal Signs And Accessories, Inc. for traffic signs at an estimated total annual premium not to exceed \$124,600 for the Stormwater Pavement and Traffic Operations Department is hereby approved and the Mayor or Mayor's Designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this transaction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this renewal will be effective through September 17, 2011.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
