TO: The Honorable Jeff Danner, Chair and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: A resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a Cooperative Funding Agreement ("Agreement") between the City of St. Petersburg and the Southwest Florida Water Management District for the design of Jungle Lake Northeast Basin (N213) stormwater conveyance system improvements. (Engineering Project No. 10007-110, Oracle No. 12549), and all other documents necessary to effectuate the Agreement; and providing an effective.

EXPLANATION: A Cooperative Funding Agreement ("Agreement") has been prepared between the Pinellas-Anclote River Basin Board of the Southwest Florida Water Management District and the City for shared equal funding in the amount of \$100,000 toward the implementation of a drainage project to alleviate street flooding along 30th Avenue North, between 75th Street North and 78th Street North.

Phase 1 of the Jungle Lake Area Stormwater System Improvement project consists of improvements to the Jungle Lake outfall structure and the stormwater culverts from Jungle Lake to Boca Ciega Bay. Phase I design is complete with bidding planned for December 2009 and construction to commence in early 2010.

Phase II of the project includes the design of stormwater drainage system improvements on 30th Avenue North between 75th Street North and 78th Street North with the goal of alleviating street flooding on 30th Avenue North, including 77th Street North. The Agreement provides for reimbursement of fifty percent (50%) of consulting engineering services related to surveying, geotechnical report, permitting, plans, bidding documents, and other services, up to but not exceeding a total aggregate amount of \$100,000. The total project design and construction cost is estimated to be \$4,200.00. Construction is planned to commence October 2012 and be completed by December 2013.

RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a Cooperative Funding Agreement ("Agreement") between the City of St. Petersburg and the Southwest Florida Water Management District for the design of Jungle Lake Northeast Basin (N213) stormwater conveyance system improvements (Engineering Project No. 10007-110, Oracle No. 12549), and all other documents necessary to effectuate the Agreement; and providing an effective date.

COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION: Funds are available in the Stormwater Drainage Capital Projects Fund (4013), Northeast Basin Jungle Lake Project (12549).

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE FUNDING AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG AND SOUTHWEST FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF JUNGLE LAKE NORTHEAST BASIN (N213) STORMWATER CONVEYANCE SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS. (ENGINEERING PROJECT NO. 10007-110, ORACLE NO. 12549) AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Cooperative Funding Agreement ("Agreement") has been prepared between the Pinellas-Anclote River Basin Board of the Southwest Florida Water Management District ("SWFWMD") and the City for shared equal funding in the amount of \$100,000 toward the implementation of the Jungle Lake Area Stormwater System Improvement project to alleviate street flooding along 30th Avenue North, between 75th Street North and 78th Street North ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the Project consists of improvements to the Jungle Lake outfall structure and the stormwater culverts from Jungle Lake to Boca Ciega Bay; and

WHEREAS, Phase I design is complete with bidding planned for December 2009 and construction to commence in early 2010; and

WHEREAS, Phase II of the Project includes the design of stormwater drainage system improvements on 30th Avenue North between 75th Street North and 78th Street North with the goal of alleviating street flooding on 30th Avenue North, including 77th Street North; and


WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for reimbursement of fifty percent (50%) of consulting engineering services related to surveying, geotechnical report, permitting, plans, bidding documents, and other services, up to but not exceeding a total aggregate amount of \$100,000, with the total Project design and construction cost estimated to be \$4,200.00; and

WHEREAS, Construction is planned to commence October 2012 and be completed by December 2013.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute a Cooperative Funding Agreement ("Agreement") between the City of St. Petersburg and Southwest Florida Water Management District for the design and construction of Jungle Lake Northeast Basin (N213) stormwater conveyance system improvements. (Engineering Project No. 10007-110, Oracle No. 12549), and all other documents necessary to effectuate the Agreement.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
