Subject: Recognition of members of the St. Petersburg Police Department's Volunteer Road Patrol.

Explanation: The members of the City's Committee to Advocate for Persons with Impairments (CAPI) is honoring the members of the Volunteer Road Patrol, in recognition of their dedication and hard work in enforcing the disabled parking provisions and statutes.

The Volunteer Road Patrol assists the Police department by tagging and impounding abandoned vehicles, often recovering stolen vehicles in the process. They transport found property to designated locations within the police department, help disabled motorists and may assist in traffic direction at vehicle crashes and fire scenes. Volunteers are also trained to issue tickets for such violations as various types of illegal parking, fire lane violations, vehicle street storage, etc.

The Parking Enforcement Specialist Unit, a separate unit of the Road Patrol, is comprised mostly of persons with disabilities who, after completing the volunteer application and training requirement, patrol in their own vehicles, citing parked vehicles that violate disabled parking regulations. A mileage reimbursement program is provided by the city to compensate for fuel usage.

In **2012 & 2013** the Road Patrol and Disabled Parking Enforcement Specialists issued 1,127 disabled parking tickets for fire lane or other types of illegal parking. They provided 11,844 total hours of voluntary service to our community during this time period. We would like to stress that these are dedicated people in our community who volunteer their time and talent to serve our city.

Revenue received from fines assessed for illegally parking in designated disabled parking spaces is split between the parking enforcement administration and an allocation designated to be used for enhancing accessibility features for City facilities, programs and services.
