### **Solicitation of Applications for Membership on the Consolidated Plan Review Committee**

The purpose of the Consolidated Plan Review Committee is to review and rank all eligible Consolidated Plan applications received from non-profit organizations. The Committee, is comprised of members representing the following groups:

Interested persons are required to submit a letter indicating their interest and resume to the Housing and Community Development Department. Persons submitting a resume for consideration cannot be on a governing board, advisory committee or staff person for any agency, organization or target area interest group which will apply for Consolidated Plan funding during the person's tenure on the Committee.

Staff will provide technical assistance to the Committee members to aid them in their review of applications. It is anticipated that the Committee will meet a maximum of two times during the month of May each year to rank and recommend projects for funding. If additional funding becomes available late in the year, additional applications may be solicited and a meeting convened to rank the additional applications.
