

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FROM WEEKI WACHEE FUNDS FOR SHAD STRUCTURES FOR THE FITNESS ZONES AT LAKE VISTA PARK AND RIVIERA PARK; APPROVING A TRANSFER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE WEEKI WACHEE OPERATING FUND (1041) TO THE WEEKI WACHEE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND (3041); APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE WEEKI WACHEE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND RESULTING FROM THIS TRANSFER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 TO THE LAKE VISTA AND RIVERA BAY PARK FITNESS ZONES SHADE STRUCTURE PROJECT (TBD); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Committee of the Whole has recommended that funding from Weeki Wachee funds be utilized to provide shade structures for the Fitness Zones at Lake Vista Park and Riviera Bay Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg hereby approves the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida that the recommendation of the Committee of the Whole to provide funding from Weeki Wachee funds for shade structures for the Fitness Zones at Lake Vista Park and Riviera Bay Park is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following transfer from the unappropriated balance of the Weeki Wachee Operating Fund (1041) to the Weeki Wachee Capital Projects Fund (3041) for Fiscal Year 2014 is hereby approved:
