TO: City Council Chair & Members of City Council

SUBJECT:

Authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services("Department") in an amount not to exceed \$497,443 for the City's summer food program and to execute a grant agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with the Department; approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$497,443 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional revenues, to the Parks & Recreation Department; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION:

The State of Florida Department of Agriculture, Division of Food, Nutrition and Wellness will award the City of St. Petersburg funding to provide breakfast and lunch for any child age 18 or under at 14 recreation sites during the summer - five days a week from June 9 until August 15. This program is funded by the US Department of Agriculture through the state and is accessible by anyone age 18 or under. A child need not be registered in a City program. The times that the meals are available are posted at each site and any child can receive breakfast and/or lunch. The grant pays for the meals and provides for an administrative cost to run the program. The reimbursement is based on how many meals are provided.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Administration recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept a grant from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services("Department") in an amount not to exceed \$497,443 for the City's summer food program and to execute a grant agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with the Department; approving a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$497,443 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional revenues, to the Parks & Recreation Department; and providing an effective date.


COST/FUNDING/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION:

Revenues of approximately \$497,443 will be received from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture. A supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$497,443 from the increase in the unappropriated balance of the General Fund (0001), resulting from these additional revenues, to the Parks & Recreation Department, Parks & Recreation Administration (190-1573) is required.



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES ("DEPARTMENT") IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$497,443 FOR THE CITY'S SUMMER FOOD PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS TRANSACTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT; APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$497,443 FROM THE INCREASE IN THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE GENERAL FUND (0001), RESULTING FROM THESE ADDITIONAL REVENUES, TO THE PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg's youth are an important and valuable resource; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Petersburg Parks & Recreation Department applied for and was awarded a grant from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services in the amount not to exceed \$497,443 to provide funding for the City's Summer Food Program providing breakfast and lunch for any child age 18 or under.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept a grant from the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services ("Department") in an amount not to exceed \$497,443 for the City's Summer Food Program and to execute a grant agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate this transaction with the Department.


