TO: The Honorable Charles W. Gerdes, Chair, and Members of City Council

SUBJECT: A resolution approving a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Fund (1023) to the Local Law Enforcement State Trust (140-2857) in the amount of \$66,000 to fund costs necessary to implement Advanced Authentication (\$45,000) and Wireless Network Access Points (\$21,000) in police vehicles; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute all documents necessary to effectuate these transactions; and providing an effective date.

EXPLANATION: The Administration requests a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Fund (1023) to the Local Law Enforcement State Trust (140-2857) in the amount of \$66,000 to fund the costs required to implement Advanced Authentication in the police vehicles (\$45,000) and to implement Wireless Network Access Points for uploading video from dash cam technology in the police cruisers (\$21,000).

The Department is mandated by the CJIS Security Policy ver 5.3 to adhere to section 5.6.2 on Advanced Authentication which requires anyone accessing CJIS data from a non-secured facility will adhere to the policy. The police vehicles are not considered a secured facility and will be required to meet this requirement. The intent of Advanced Authentication is to meet the standards of two-factor authentication.

The Wireless Network Access Points will be a part of a dedicated network with the sole intention of uploading video to a secure server behind the Police Department's firewall. This will also include the cost to run the network cable to each of the Access Points.

RECOMMENDATION: The administration recommends that City Council adopt the attached resolution approving a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Fund (1023) to the Local Law Enforcement State Trust (140-2857) in the amount of \$66,000 to fund costs necessary to implement Advanced Authentication (\$45,000) and Wireless Network Access Points (\$21,000) in police vehicles; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute all documents necessary to effectuate these transactions; and providing an effective date.

COST/FUNDING INFORMATION: Funds for the implementation of Advanced Authentication and installation of Wireless Network Access Points will be available after the approval of a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$66,000 from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Fund (1023) to the Local Law Enforcement State Trust (140-2857).

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND (1023) TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT STATE TRUST (140-2857) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$66,000 TO FUND COSTS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT ADVANCED AUTHENTICATION (\$45,000) AND WIRELESS NETWORK ACCESS POINTS (\$21,000) IN POLICE VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THESE TRANSACTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Administration has requested a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Fund (1023) to the Police Department, Local Law Enforcement State Trust (140-2857) in the amount of \$66,000; and

WHEREAS, the funds appropriated to the Police Department, Local Law Enforcement State Trust (140-2857) will be used for the implementation of Advanced Authentication and Wireless Network Access Points in police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Department is mandated by the CJIS Security Policy ver 5.3 to adhere to section 5.6.2 on Advanced Authentication which requires anyone accessing CJIS data from a non-secured facility to adhere to the policy; and

WHEREAS, Wireless Network Access Points are needed for a dedicated network behind the Police Department's firewall to upload video from dash cam technology in police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, the requested appropriation is for authorized uses for the Law Enforcement Fund (1023).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, that there is hereby approved from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Fund (1023), the following supplemental appropriation for FY2016:
