#39 BAYBORO HARBOR REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG, FLORIDA - APPROVED \*

County Administrator Fred E. Marquis recommended approval of the Bayboro Harbor Redevelopment Plan for the City of St. Petersburg, and said that the Plan had been approved by the Planning Department and the Pinellas Planning Council.

In response to Commissioner Greer's question, Mr. Marquis explained that the County's contract with the City, which authorizes redevelopment rights, requires Board approval for any amendments, changes, deletions, and additions to the Plan.

Replying to query by Commissioner Todd, Mr. Marquis advised that the subject plan is part of the City's master development plan; that the matter had been before the Board "two or three" times previously; and that it is a minor amendment to the original plan.

In answer to Commissioner Chesnut's question, Mr. Marquis indicated that under the redevelopment plan, the Board has restricted condemnation proceedings to only the City Council; and that subsequent to approval by the Board, the City is required to hold public hearings on the matter.

Commissioner Greer moved, seconded by Commissioner Chesnut and carried, that the recommendation of the County Administrator be approved.
