No person will use the public wharves of the City for the purpose of storage of any matter except for such reasonable time as may be absolutely necessary in the launching or retrieving of boats.

Before using the above-listed public wharves, the operators of commercial vessels must obtain a permit. The annual permit fee is \$235.00 (pro-rated at \$20 per month) and the use permit sticker must be affixed to the commercial vessel on the port side adjacent to the Florida registration and must be visible at all times. Each vessel requires its own permit which is valid from January 1 to December 31.

The applicant, for himself/herself and for other persons and/or organizations, if any, listed on this application, does hereby agree to jointly and severally defend, indemnify and hold free and harmless the City of St. Petersburg, Florida from any and all claims for damages or loss of property or injury to or death of person(s) arising out of or resulting from the issuance of this permit and the use of the public wharves listed on the application.

Commercial vessels, their operators and persons on them must comply with all rules and regulations with respect to the use of the permit sticker issued by the Parks Department and all City ordinances and State laws. Failure to comply with or violation of any City ordinance or any of the terms or rules and regulations of the use permit shall be a violation of this section and carry a penalty as provided in Section 1-7. The use permit sticker may be revoked immediately upon the issuance of a notice to appear in County Court for an ordinance violation and/or upon notice being given that there has been a violation of a rule or regulation governing the permit sticker. Permit sticker revocations may be appealed by the permittee to the Mayor and from the Mayor to City Council.
