Large Quantity of Methamphetamine Located in St. Petersburg Home

At about 6:50 p.m. officers responded to 4750 24th Avenue North after receiving a tip of methamphetamine being produced at that location.

Officers spoke to a resident at that address who was cooperative and consented to a search of the home. That search revealed what is being described as a trafficking amount of methamphetamine in one of the rooms of the residence.

The St. Petersburg Fire Department Hazmat Unit led by Lt. Randy Kahler responded to the scene to evaluate the possibility of a meth lab being on the premises. None was found and it appears that the house was only being utilized for the storage and distribution of the drug.

Detectives of the St. Petersburg Police Department Narcotics Unit have responded to the scene to conduct further investigation into activities at the home.

At this time the investigation is ongoing and additional details will be released when appropriate.
