INCIDENT: Fatal Crash

SYNOPSIS:

A 2003 Saturn four door sedan, FL tag U51SD, being driven by Devin M. Plant (W/M, 09/20/1985, 201 37th Avenue Northeast, St Pete) was eastbound on 62nd Avenue North, attempting to turn left onto 22nd Street. Charles R. Lutec II (W/M, 11/02/1985, 654 39th Avenue Northeast, St. Pete) was seated in the right rear seat and Diana L. Nusspickel (W/F, 01/30/1986, 1124 54th Avenue North, St. Pete) was seated in the left rear seat of the Saturn. A 2007 Chevrolet two door sedan, FL tag X38UQU, being driven by Scott M. Nicholson (W/M, 05/04/1981, 1521 34th Avenue North, St. Pete) was westbound in the median lane of 62nd Avenue North at an extremely high rate of speed. The Chevrolet locked his brakes and slid into the right side of the Saturn. The Chevrolet continued sliding, coming to rest against the north curb line of 62nd Avenue North, west of 22nd Street. The Saturn spun counter-clockwise, partially leaving the north curb line and impacted a bus stop sign and a wooden power pole.

Lutec II and Nusspickel were both pronounced dead at the scene. Plant was transported to Bayfront Medical Center in life-threatening condition. Nicholson was transported to Bayfront medical center in serious condition.
