Update re. Last Night's Stabbing at 1915 17 Street South

Detectives have learned that prior to the stabbing which resulted in the victim Otis Wilson death, Wilson was involved in a physical altercation with his wife, Paula L. Wilson, DOB 09/17/70, who also resides at the 17 Street address.

During this altercation Paula Wilson's 16 year old son, Derrion Adams, obtained a knife from a kitchen drawer and stabbed Otis Wilson multiple times in the torso and leg area. Adams is Otis Wilson's step-son.

After the stabbing, Paula Wilson contacted the police and both she and her son remained on the scene until officers arrived. Derrion turned the knife over to officers as they approached him and acknowledged stabbing the victim.

The victim was found sitting in a chair on the front porch bleeding from his wounds and was unconscious. He was transported to Bayfront Medical Center where he later died from his injuries.

Derrion Adams did give a statement to detectives indicating that he was acting in defense of his mother at the time he stabbed Wilson.

He was charged as a juvenile with Manslaughter and transported to the Juvenile Detention Center.
